

### **Authorization to Use the Library**

The Library of the Staatsgalerie Stuttgart is a specialized art history library with around 130,000 publications on European and American artists. Its main focus is on artist monographs and exhibition catalogues, supplemented by encyclopedias, scholarly literature, and an ongoing journal collection. The development of the collection is based in particular on a continuous exchange of publications with more than 100 institutions in Germany and abroad. As a reference library, its holdings are available—after prior registration—to art historians, students, and members of the public interested in art.

### **General Information on Use**

The library can be used by prior appointment via email or telephone. Workstations with power outlets are available. As this is a reference library, publications unfortunately cannot be borrowed. Copies and scans may be made in compliance with copyright regulations.

Upon request, the library team can search for the desired literature and make it available. It is also possible to assemble a reference collection (hand apparatus) for a defined period. Media must be returned via the library staff. Please place the books on one of the two book carts in the entrance area for this purpose.

### **Research**

The holdings can be searched electronically via the online catalog (OPAC) for publications from the year 1999 onward. Publications published before 1998 are being gradually recorded digitally as part of the ongoing »Retrokatalogisierung« project.

### **Conduct**

Eating, drinking, and smoking are not permitted in the library. Please keep noise to a minimum and follow the instructions of the library staff. If you have any questions or uncertainties, please contact the staff members.
